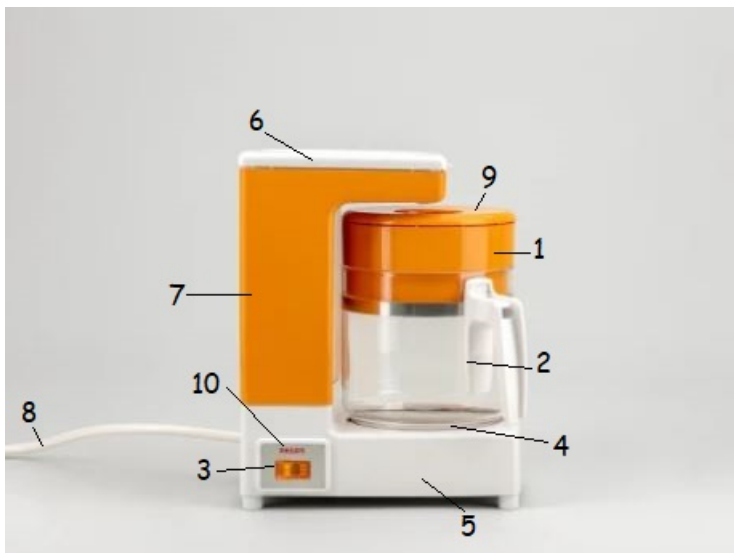


Figure 2: MoccaBlaster coffee maker

Brewing coffee with MoccaBlaster

This module provides a guide on how to brew coffee with a MoccaBlaster coffee maker.

To brew coffee, you need:

- one MoccaBlaster coffee maker
- filter ground coffee
- coffee filters.



Note: Only use unbleached coffee filters with MoccaBlaster EX2000

- Water

If you do not yet have access to intravenous caffeine injections, you can get unrivalled caffeine jolts by drinking coffee brewed in a MoccaBlaster coffee maker.

1. Pour a desired amount of water into the water container.

If the water container overflows and there is now water on your kitchen counter, you have poured too much water into the container. To rectify the situation, repeat step 1 with less water.

2. Put a coffee filter into the coffee grounds container.
3. Measure a decent amount of coffee grounds into the filter.

For the best result, always use at least double the amount of coffee grounds compared to the amount of water.

If you use four cups of water, use at least eight full scoops of coffee grounds. Otherwise, your coffee might be weak and watery.

4. Turn on your MoccaBlaster by pressing the **power button**.

5. Wait patiently for 60 minutes.

You have coffee.



DANGER: The coffee you brewed may be hot. Drink with caution.

Cleaning Moccablaster

This module provides a guide on how to keep your MoccaBlaster device clean and hygienic.

For the best coffee experience, clean your MoccaBlaster thoroughly once every three months. If you do not clean your MoccaBlaster, the coffee might develop a curious aftertaste.

Cleaning MoccaBlaster on the outside

1. Select an instrument to wipe the outside of your MoccaBlaster. You can use:

- a dish rag
- a paper towel
- a piece of clothing.

2. Using your cleaning instrument of choice, wipe off all the muck that has collected on the outside of your MoccaBlaster.

If there is a stain that you cannot remove with the cleaning instrument alone, use turpentine.

Removing calcium deposits inside MoccaBlaster

3. In a medium-sized jug, mix one liter of room temperature water with three table spoons of baking soda.



Note: You can also use a brand calcium remover, but baking soda works just fine and is much cheaper.

4. Pour the mix into the MoccaBlaster's water container and press the **power button**.

5. When half of the water has gone through MoccaBlaster's innards, turn off the device by pressing the **power button** again.

Let the water sit in the coffee maker for 30 minutes.

6. After 30 minutes, turn your MoccaBlaster back on.

Rinsing the inside of the coffee maker after removing calcium deposits

7. Fill the water container with cold water.

8. Press the **power button**.

To make sure all baking soda has been removed, repeat steps 7-8 two times.

Your MoccaBlaster is clean and the coffee should not taste odd anymore.

Connecting MoccaBlaster EX2000 to a wireless local-area network

This module contains a guide on how to connect your MoccaBlaster EX2000 to a wireless local-area network (WLAN).

To establish a connection between a wireless network and MoccaBlaster EX2000, you need:

- A MoccaBlaster EX2000 coffee maker
- A WLAN access point
- Patience, as setting up an internet connection may be time-consuming and irksome.

To make the connection process easier, move your MoccaBlaster EX2000 close to your WLAN access point.

If you happen to be a luddite who does not have access to the internet, you cannot use this unique and superbly useful feature.

1. Turn on your MoccaBlaster EX2000 by pressing the **power button**.

When you turn on the coffee maker, it begins to scan the surrounding interwebs for accessible WLAN connections automatically. To disable this feature, press the power button for three seconds.

2. Wait patiently for MoccaBlaster EX2000 to connect to your WLAN.

Establishing the connection can take a few minutes.

When the WLAN connection is ready, the power button on your MoccaBlaster EX2000 turns blue.

If your MoccaBlaster EX2000 fails to connect to WLAN or connects to the wrong WLAN, repeat steps 1-2 and hope for the desired result.

After you have connected your coffee maker to the internet, you can:

- Go to www.moccablaster.com/on-off-button/ to turn your coffee maker on and off.
- Return your MoccaBlaster EX2000 to the kitchen. It does not need to stay close to the WLAN access point after you have established the WLAN connection.
- [Troubleshoot the internet connection](#) if necessary.

Brewing coffee remotely on a web browser

This module contains a guide on how to brew coffee with MoccaBlaster EX2000 via a web browser (a very useful functionality indeed).

To brew coffee remotely on a web browser, you need:

- A MoccaBlaster EX2000 coffee maker
- A WLAN access point
- A device you can use to access the internet (phone, laptop, etc.)

We recommend that you always turn on your VPN connection before connecting your MoccaBlaster coffee maker to the internet. If you do not use a VPN connection, a third party may hack your coffee maker and use it to brew coffee without asking you first.



Important: Make sure your MoccaBlaster EX2000 is connected to the internet before brewing coffee remotely. For more information on how to connect the coffee maker to the internet, see [Connecting MoccaBlaster EX2000 to a wireless local-area network](#) on page 18.

1. Put a desired amount of coffee grounds and water into the coffee maker.
2. Turn on your MoccaBlaster EX2000 by pressing the **power button**.
3. On your browser device, go to www.moccablaster.com/online-brewing/.
4. On the top of the webpage, select the **Remote brewing** tab.
5. In the **MoccaBlaster ID** field, insert the personal serial number of your MoccaBlaster EX2000.
You can find the personal serial number for your MoccaBlaster coffee maker on the underside of the machine.
6. On your browser, click the **Brew now!** button.
Your MoccaBlaster EX2000 begins to brew coffee.

After you have remotely brewed coffee on your MoccaBlaster EX2000, you can:

- Drink the coffee.
- Muse on the possibilities of modern technology, such as brewing coffee remotely.

MoccaBlaster: troubleshooting

A table of common problems you might encounter while using your MoccaBlaster.

Table 1: Troubleshooting MoccaBlaster

Problem	Solution
My MoccaBlaster does not work.	Plug your MoccaBlaster into a power socket and try again.
My coffee is cold.	Put your cup of coffee into the microwave at 800 W for two minutes.
The coffee pot of my MoccaBlaster is broken.	Buy a new one.
My MoccaBlaster is loud.	Leave the room while MoccaBlaster is turned on or buy a pair of earplugs.
MoccaBlaster does not meet my expectations.	That's too bad.
My internet connection is unstable.	Reboot your WLAN access point and reconnect your MoccaBlaster to WLAN .. If this does not help, you might consider investing in a fiber-optic internet for your household. Additionally, you can make coffee without using the internet.
